The annual JUBILEE Conference in Pittsburgh is designed to help you wrestle deeply with the challenges of being a follower of Jesus, a citizen of His Kingdom, and of this world. Jubilee will inspire you to see the world as Jesus sees it; it will connect you with amazing people, and it will give you a powerful vision of your place in God's story. It's a great opportunity to spend a day thinking about life and where and how we fit into the world. It's also a good time of fellowship, and a special experience to be there with 1500+ other college students in the Pittsburgh Convention Center. Please plan your schedule so you can attend! ICF can provide a scholarship to pay \$75 of the \$95 one-day conference fee! You only pay \$20, plus the cost of "fast food" lunch and dinner. We will cover the transportation costs. Here is some more information:

The JUBILEE Conference will be held at the Westin Convention Center in Pittsburgh on Feb. 19-21. Our PSU international group will just attend the conference for the day on **Saturday, Feb. 20**. We will leave State College at 7 AM (I will pick you up wherever you live in State College), and return by midnight. During the afternoon "Breakout Sessions" you can choose between a variety of speakers and topics. Over the lunch break we will explore some of downtown Pittsburgh together. In the evening there will be some great singing and a featured speaker. (Also, there are special programs available for African and African-American students, and for Latino students.)
